

FWC Scrip FAQ's

Q: How do the rebates work?

A: When you buy Scrip, the vendor rebates a percentage to FWC. That rebate will be split 50/50 between the school and your family's tuition account, credited once per year.

Q: When will my portion of the rebate be credited?

A: Any rebate earned between now and the end of May will be credited to your account on May 31, 2010, just before tuition is due for the 10/11 school year. Anything purchased from June 1, 2010 through May 31, 2011 will be credited for the 11/12 school year using the same process.

Q: Where does the school portion of the money go?

A; The only expenses to paid out of the school's portion is for shipping of the Scrip orders. All of the remaining money goes toward the Facilities Master Plan. For more information on the plan go to the FWC website and click on "Giving".

Q: What does this cost me? It seems too good to be true.

A: This program costs you nothing, other than your time to order and pick up Scrip at the Cardinal Store.

Q: My youngest child will be a Senior next year. Does it make sense for me to participate?

A: Absolutely!! Not only will you be helping the school, but if your youngest is a Senior, we'll be crediting your account early, on January 1. The school has authorized that these funds can be used to help pay for the Senior Trip. Any rebates earned after January 1 will go into an FWC Scholarship Fund.

Q: What if we leave FWC?

A: If your child(ren) is not re-enrolled for the upcoming year by May 31, any rebate on account will be forfeited and will go 100% to the school.

Q: I'm a teacher/staff member. Can I participate?

A: Of course! If you have a child that currently attends FWC, your benefits are identical to that of every other family. If you don't have a child attending, your half of the rebate will go to an FWC Scholarship Fund. Unfortunately, we cannot allow you to designate another family for the benefit unless you are a relative...an aunt, uncle, grandparent, etc.

Q: My child has a grandparents who wants to buy. Can I ask others to buy Scrip for my family account?

A: Yes, with a few exceptions. Anyone can buy Scrip, as long as you will be responsible for delivery to the person. We cannot mail Scrip from the school. Also, only FWC faculty/staff that are relatives can credit Scrip rebates to your account. Otherwise, it would be inappropriate to ask FWC staff to participate for your financial benefit.

Q: Will other school organizations, like Booster Club and PTO, be participating?

A: We hope so, because 100% of those rebates go to the school.

Q: Can we use a credit card to pay for Scrip?

A: No. The fees credit card companies charge eats into the rebates. The only form of payment for FWC Scrip is Presto Pay, which is an electronic check used for online payments such as tax payments.

Q: Where do I pick up my order?

A: In the Cardinal Store during regular store hours.

Q: Can I order Scrip during the summer?

A: Yes! The Cardinal Store is closed during the summer, so contact the Scrip Coordinator for alternate pick up location.

Q: Can Scrip be shipped directly to me, or someone else?

A: No. Scrip can only be picked up at the Cardinal Store.

Q: Is there a way for me to know how much I have coming to me?

A: Your account will keep a running total which you will split 50/50 with the school.
