As a follow-up to our communication yesterday, I wanted to give you a brief update as promised. Our Leadership Team met virtually this afternoon. We spent a considerable amount of time during our call talking about and praying for the well-being of all our FWC community impacted directly or indirectly by COVID-19.

We were in the middle of our long conference call when we received news that President Trump would be holding an important press conference, so our meeting was adjourned to hear if there might any sweeping changes or new information that would impact our response.

The President's announcement reinforced our commitment to exploring innovative ways that Fort Worth Christian will continue our shift to a modified delivery of our Christ-centered, college preparatory education for the next several weeks.

Our COVID-19 Task Force will remotely reconvene once again late this evening to further our discussion and thoughtfully determine how this will happen. It is our intent to communicate again by midday tomorrow with many more details. We are also developing a landing page on our website to answer as many questions as possible. It is our hope to have this webpage live within 24-48 hours.

We continue to ask for your prayers as we guide our students and faculty during this unprecedented time in history.
